Under FM- Anesthesia, dermatology, emergency medicine, general surgery, gynecology, FM inpatient, interventional radiology, radiology, night float(FM), orthopedics, pain management, pediatrics, psychiatry, radiation oncology, radiology, research (FM), rural medicine, sports medicine (FM)

Vacation:

Vacation 20 days maximum per year - not allowed on: Inpatient, Night Float, GS, Radiology, and ICU

*Transitional year interns will be incorporated into the intern class of each of the IM and FM sponsoring programs. Interns interested in specialties supported by the internal medicine education will follow the internal medicine rotational experiences with increased inpatient rotations and practice. While interns who are interested in specialties involving a broader patient population will participate in rotations with the family medicine residency program. Transitional year and categorical residents will participate in the same pre-established rotations and be supervised and taught by the same faculty members, ensuring consistent educational experiences across both groups.
Determination of assigned track once accepted into the Transitional Year program will be decided by the Program Director.
